Dear Mr. President,

I am writing to you, to follow-up an email I sent you through the Office of Presidential Correspondence on November 16th.

This letter has two goals in it's drafting, the first is to provide the background on "America, The Example" and the second is to say "Thank You", for standing in the gap and taking the arrows to protect the Freedoms we hold dear.

The background behind "America, The Example."

In 2019, I set out to study God's Providence in the founding of the United States of America. As I embarked on my journey, I was turned on to a specific book, "The Light and the Glory" by Peter Marshall and David Manuel. As I finished the first of three books, it finished with the American Revolution and as I did, I needed to take a business trip to Lynn, Massachusetts for GE Aviation. During my short trip in mid-September 2019, I set some time aside to visit some of the sites I had just finished reading about in the book.
